¿Qué es TOEFL? El Test of English as a Foreign Language es un examen internacional de desempeño en inglés, desarrollado por medio de la prestigiosa empresa ETS (English Language Teaching), el cual busca medir los conocimientos en dicha lengua de hablantes no nativos. Al igual que otros exámenes internacionales, es requerido por algunas entidades educativas, compañías y embajadas en el extranjero, para efectos de estudio, trabajo o procesos de inmigración. Los niveles de inglés que se certifican corresponden a los niveles elemental (A1/A2), intermedio (B1/B2) y avanzado (C1/C2), de acuerdo a la nomenclatura asignada para cada uno y descrita en el Marco Común de Referencia Europeo para las Lenguas (2001).

Certificación TOEFL

Por medio de ETS, nuestros alumnos(as) de **7° Básico** y **IV° Medio** tendrán la posibilidad, sin discriminación de ningún tipo, de rendir la evaluación **TOEFL**. Esta examinación es tomada por ETS en el establecimiento y los resultados son entregados dentro de 48 horas hábiles y puede ser realizada según horario pedido por el establecimiento. Este examen es para “todos los alumnos y alumnas de Colegio Superior Cambridge”, ya que este proceso no conlleva un costo adicional para los apoderados.

Tecnologías

Todos los recursos asociados al proyecto están apoyados en base a herramientas tecnológicas. Por esto, existe la posibilidad tanto para los alumnos(as) como los profesores de acceder a la plataforma con acceso al libro digital, E-Reader y material interactivo (dependiendo del nivel), sumado a esto, los docentes tendrán acceso a material de gran ayuda para potenciar su labor de enseñanza.

Existen áreas dentro de cada uno de los recursos que potencian habilidades productivas y colaborativas como son la elaboración de proyectos de unidad y metacognición. Ambos procesos de gran importancia y valorados dentro de la planificación y la propuesta docente del recurso.

Los recursos pedagógicos (textos), según carga horaria, propuesto para los ciclos de preescolar y básica están enfocados en el aprendizaje del idioma inglés ligado a un contexto literario (Reading based learning), el cual permitirá además el desarrollo de habilidades literarias y procesos propios de la comprensión lectora, pero dentro en un contexto idiomático. Sumado a lo anterior, desarrollo de las cuatro habilidades (Reading, listening, writing & speaking) con un enfoque comunicativo sobre metodologías dinámicas e interactivas que permiten a los estudiantes mantener la motivación y aprendizajes en contextos cercanos, lúdicos y desafiantes.

Para educación media I-world es la propuesta metodológica innovadora en la cual se potencia el desarrollo de habilidades del siglo XXI en conjunción con potentes proyectos de unidad (Project Based Learning) y la clase invertida (Flipped Classroom). Se potencia el desarrollo del ciudadano digital por medio del uso pedagógico de tecnologías y sus recursos.

For young students, to measure current English skills and provide a foundation for future success (age 8+)

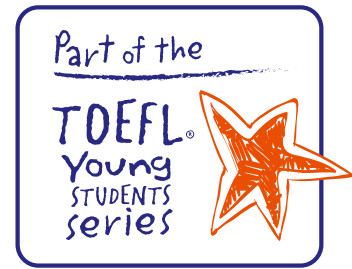

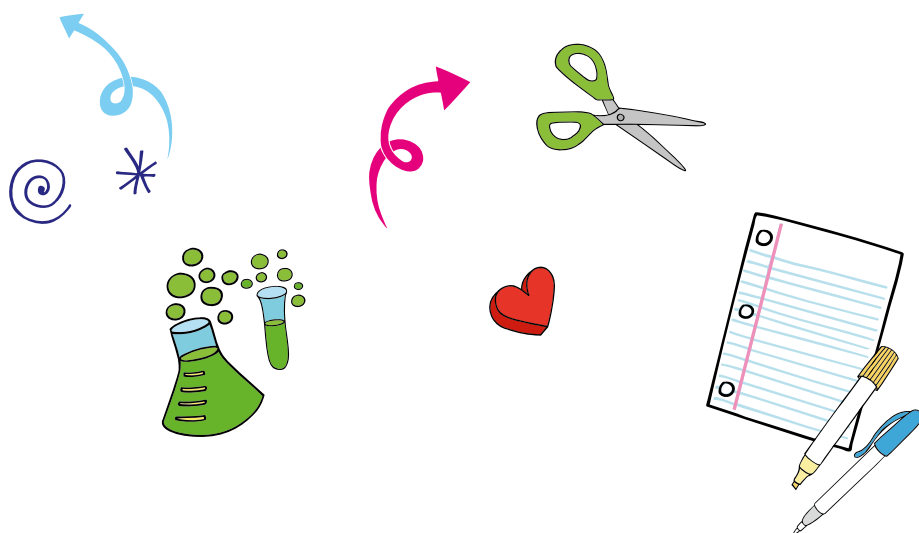
